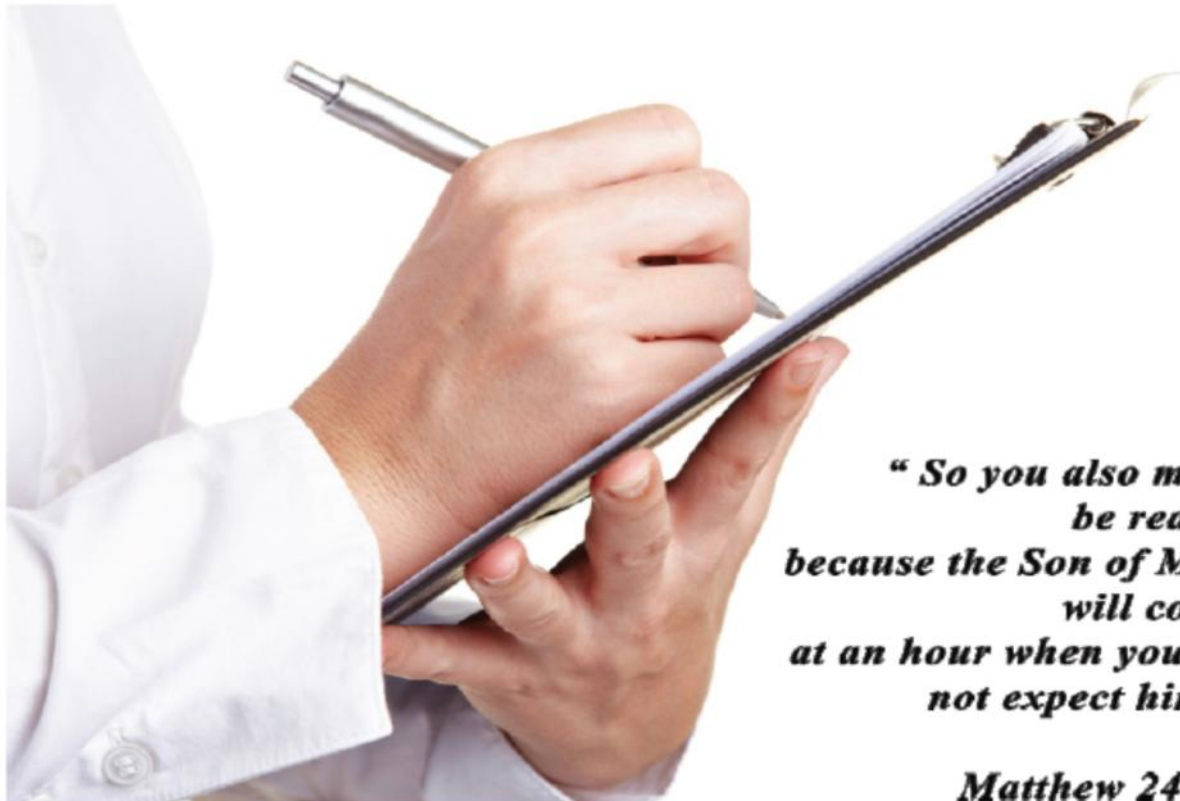


CHECKLIST FOR ETERNITY

1. God has appointed unto all men once to dies (Hebrews 9:27).

Have I given serious thought to the eternally important matter of preparing spiritually for death?

2. All people will someday be judged by God (Ecclesiastes: 12: 13-14, Revelations 20: 11-15, John 12: 48).

Am I diligently preparing for the greatest of all tests?

3. Christ has told men what to do in order to go to Heaven (Acts 2:38, John 3: 34, Romans 10:17, 2 Thessalonians 1: 8).

Am I willing to hear and obey Christ in order to be saved from my sins?

4. A responsible person must believe in Christ -- in His person, in His commandments, and in His promises (Hebrew 11: 6, Acts 16: 31, John 8: 24).

Do I truly believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God?

5. God commands all men everywhere to repent of past sins and to return to Him (Acts 17: 30-31, Luke 13: 3-5, Acts 2: 38).

Have I truly repented of the sins which I have done?

6. God requires that men confess their faith in Jesus Christ (Matthew 10:32-33, Philippians 2: 5-11, Romans 10: 9-10).

Have I confessed my faith that Jesus Christ is the Son of God?

7. Jesus has commanded us to be baptized (Matthew 28: 18-20, Mark 16: 15-16). There is one baptism commanded in the New Testament (Ephesians 4: 4-6). It is a burial or planting (Romans 6: 4-5) in water (John 3: 3-5, Acts 10: 47-48, Acts 8: 36-39) for the remission of sins (Acts 2: 38). It is to “wash away” sins, to put one into Christ (1 Corinthians 12: 13, Romans 6: 1-4, Galatians 3: 26- 29), and to save one from past sins (Mark 16: 15-16; 1 Peter 3: 21 Acts 22: 16).

Have I been baptized according to the New Testament pattern?

8. When one is baptized, the Lord adds him to the church (Acts 2: 41, 47, Ephesians 5: 22-33).

9. As a member of the church, one is to be regular and faithful in attendance at worship services (Hebrews 10: 24-31). He is to worship God in the name of Christ (Colossians 3: 17). Specific items of worship in the New Testament include singing (Ephesians 5: 19, Colossians 3: 16), partaking of the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 11: 23-34), giving (1 Corinthians 16: 1-2, 2 Corinthians 9: 6-15), praying (Acts 2: 42, 1 Timothy 2: 8), and listening to God's Word as it is taught and proclaimed (Acts 20: 7, 2 Timothy 4: 1-8).

Am I being faithful in attending church services and in worshipping God?

10. Christ commands His disciples to live a morally clean life, to do good unto all men, and to press on toward the Heavenly Home (Romans 12:1-2, Galatians 6 :9-10, Philippians 3 :8-11, 1 Corinthians 9: 23-27; Matthew 24: 45-51)

Am I truly living the Christian life?
